

CAUTION: RED FLAG PROBLEMS!!!

If you check **any** of the boxes below, you need to consult with an immigration expert **BEFORE** applying for citizenship. These problems will not *necessarily* disqualify you. However, they may have **serious consequences** if you don't see an expert. An expert can determine whether you are still eligible to apply.

Check the boxes that apply to you:

- I lived in another country after getting my legal permanent resident status.
- I traveled outside the U.S. for more than six months after getting my green card.
- I got married in order to get a green card.
- I lied in order to get a green card or I was not eligible for the green card at that time.
- I re-married without legally terminating my previous marriage.
- I helped someone enter the U.S. illegally.
- I have been involved in certain political movements, such as communism.
- I have contradictory information on my N-400 application that doesn't agree with information I provided on other USCIS applications.
- I failed to file income taxes, or filed as a non-resident.
- I am a male and I did not register for the Selective Service as required.
- I lied or committed fraud in order to receive or continue to receive public benefits.
- I falsely claimed to be a U.S. citizen.
- I did not provide financial support to my children.
- I have been charged with domestic violence, child abuse, or child neglect.
- I am on probation or parole.
- I have been ordered deported, in the past or present.
- I have been arrested or convicted of a crime.
- I have been fingerprinted by the police.
