The fee for the N-400 naturalization application will increase on Oct. 2, 2020

- The naturalization application fee will increase from \$640 to \$1,170 (this fee includes the cost of biometrics).
- N-400 fee waivers will only be available to certain humanitarian applicants who can show household income at or below 125% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Fee waivers based on financial hardship or receipt of a meanstested benefit are no longer available.
- Applicants can no longer request a reduced (\$320) filing fee based on a household income between 150% and 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Form I-942 is being eliminated.
- Due to USCIS backlogs, it is likely that delays in naturalization application decisions will continue. Filing your N-400 before the Oct. 2, 2020, changes can save you and your family money.
